

**NORTH WEST VICTORIAN
MOTORCYCLE CLUB
Supplementary Regulations
2010**

1. Points will be awarded in each round of the Motocross, Dirt Track and Enduro, with each discipline being 3 separate series'.
2. There will be 3 rounds each of Dirt Track, Motocross and Enduro.
3. Rider's points will go towards each aggregate and also to the Club Champion, with the maximum points per day being 25.
 - (a) To be eligible for club aggregate in each discipline a rider must participate in 2 of the 3 rounds of Dirt Track, 2 of the 3 rounds of Motocross and 2 of the 3 rounds of Enduro.
 - (b) To be eligible for Club Champion a rider must participate in all 3 disciplines. (This means a rider must participate in 2 out of 3 Motocross, 2 out of 3 Dirt Track and 2 out of 3 Enduro events to be eligible).
 - (c) If a rider enters a pony express or a sidecar class, only 1/2 points will be awarded.
4. There must be 3 riders with points at the end of the year to constitute a class, unless at the discretion of the committee at the end of the year.
5. If any rider moves into a different class throughout the year for any reason, their points do not go with them.
6. Pit riding or riding on the access roads at the meeting is prohibited.
7. Officials and club members assisting on race meeting days need to be dressed appropriately. Wearing boots or fully closed in shoes are required at all times, this includes in the pit area, doing flag duty and as well as those riding motorbikes as vehicle recovery. Also the wearing of helmets and appropriate safety gear is compulsory.
8. Officials riding a motorcycle must not do so while any form of racing is in progress. These should be used for recovery vehicles only. Enduros are exempt.
9. No person under the age of 16 is permitted on any track to attend to any role in an official capacity.
10. No consumption of alcohol will be permitted in the pit area. Refer: GCR 4.1.4.4 of competition rulebook.
11. No dogs allowed on complex. Refer: GCR 4.1.4.5 of competition rulebook.
12. No pushbikes or scooters allowed in the pits.
13. Cars and Trailers are prohibited in pit area, this applies for Motocross and Dirt Track only.
14. No glass on complex and at events.
15. No knobby tyres permitted on the Dirt Track from 125cc upwards, unless at the committees discretion of a particular event.
16. During racing when riders fall, parents and officials are not to go onto the race track or move riders that may be injured until the Ambulance have attended to them first.
17. Protective mating - See Rule 20.5.0.3. Club Ruling - Dirt Track, Long Track, Enduro & Motocross.
18. Proof of Ambulance must be sighted.
